- Liquitex Gloss Medium 16 oz size Best price = \$15.15 at Walmart.com (not sold in store; on-line only) Second best price = \$25.99 at Michael's (minus 40% if you source a coupon)
- Brayer/roller 4-inch width -- \$8.69 at Walmart.com
- Paintbrush (2 inches wide); from hardware store
- Old washcloth (for scrubbing paper)
- Small plastic bowl (to hold water)
- Large scissors (to cut paper and fabric)
- Disposable latex gloves
