We initiated a partnership with local restaurants by offering an iPad for a winning patron who brought the entry form to the Festival...The Bancroft Gallery featured quilts from a Mid-Western quilting group, a great backdrop to the Festival jazz reception. Both the Bancroft and Dillon galleries each summer showcase our talented members' work in the Blue Ribbon Members' Show... The SSAC exhibition year opened with a curated show Women 360 featuring work by artists who interpreted issues relating to women...Our weekly Artist in Residence program featured a new artist, sculptor Susan Luery from Hingham. 





2013 Dorothy Palmer Painting Prize Winner

This upcoming school year, sculptor Susan Luery will return as our Artist in Residence for this highly-acclaimed program. Known locally for her sculpture of the mother and daughter reading outside the Hingham Public Library, as well as her sculpture of St. Paul, outside St. Paul's Parish in Hingham, Susan's work can be found in private, public and museum collections throughout the world. A favorite sculpture is her monumental work, "Babe's Dream," the 16-foot monument of Babe Ruth standing in front of Oriole Park at Camden Yards in Baltimore.

This past year, the ninth year of this extremely popular outreach program, Susan enchanted visiting students with her introduction to large three-dimensional works by a number of modern sculptors and their creation. She showed the students how she works from drawings and scale models to the process of casting large scale bronze figures in her studio to installation of her sculptures in parks and private settings. The students also had the opportunity to create a head out of clay, working with our talented volunteer teachers, to take home.

Groups of 40-60 students (3rd, 4th and 5th grade) are invited to participate in this program, offered on Wednesday mornings throughout the school year. 

A Master Class

July 13–16 Saturday through Tuesday 9:30 – 4:30 \$450M \$500NM

This four day "art making" workshop will revolve around the 'Solarplate Process' and will require established printmakers to have a good background with both the processing and printing of Solarplates. Dan will demonstrate both relief and intaglio methods, as well as color printing and creating various "Hybrid Works". Participants will be encouraged to utilize embossment as well as a layering of color. Each person may choose to work on multiple plates and many images, or concentrate on a series of works from a single image.

502 "Masks and Mirrors" Portraiture Today: A Drawing Class

July 30 and August 1, August 6 and 8 Tuesday and Thursday 10:00 – 4:00 \$450M \$500NM

What is portraiture in the 21st century? How do you see yourself and others?

We will look for new ways to visualize the portrait. What is behind the mask and how much of it do we need to see? What associations, artifacts, symbols and mediums help define our inner lives? We will examine the perceptual vs. the conceptual and the direct vs. the indirect ways of arriving at images to construct an individual's identity. Problems will be given as starting points, with some work to be done in class and outside of class. Experimentation with collage is highly encouraged, using



old letters, pages from cookbooks, art books, newspapers, plastic, wood, cloth fragments, anything that will stimulate an idea to build on. This course moves into the known and the unknown areas of portraiture where daring and imagination are necessary to express how other visual concepts about art related to form and content can be developed. The class is divided into two weeks, two days a week to allow for the digestion of ideas to build on.
