About SSAC

South Shore Art Center's mission is to enrich the communities south of Boston by engaging artists and by fostering an understanding and appreciation of the visual arts through exhibitions and education.



Founded in 1955, South Shore Art Center (SSAC) grew from a chance meeting in Cohasset Common when Helen Howe Vossoff, President of the then newly-formed South Shore Music Circus, stumbled upon artists Tom Lucas and MacIvor Reddie painting en plein air. The three embarked on a long conversation about the need for a local art center. Soon thereafter they organized an active group of similarly-minded individuals. Within one year, they had established art classes, registered 110 students and attracted 100 members to their cause. They celebrated with a community arts festival at the scene of the inspiration: Cohasset Common. Art was everywhere – propped on easels and pinned



on clotheslines strung from trees. The excitement of so much talent in one small place over one short weekend inspired an annual event that has grown in scale and scope to become one of the most-anticipated festivals of the region.




And here we are celebrating our 64th annual Arts Festival! Thank you for helping us make history by participating in this wonderful art immersion.

The guidelines for applying to and/or nominating a candidate to the Deedee Awards are below.

GENERAL INFORMATION ABOUT BOTH DEEDEE AGEE AWARDS

- Application deadline is Monday, September 9. Both awards will be given at the Art Center's Annual Meeting, or October 21, 2019.
- Candidates for the "Emerging Artist of the Year" should be local artists at the beginning of their career or returning to the discipline of art-making after a break. Awardees will receive \$1,000.
- The "Student Artist of the Year" is a need-based scholarship for a local middle or high school student demonstrating commitment to and talent in the visual arts. Candidates for this scholarship should be nominated by a member of the SSAC faculty or by an art instructor at an area school. Awardees will receive a certificate valued for one free SSAC art class (up to a \$250 value).
