

## 565 LAYERING MEDIA – Lisa Pressman

**Materials fee 30:00 for me for additional supplies: paint, ink, pastels, papers, tools, etc.**

⤴ 15 pieces of cheap paper - 6 x 6, 8 x 8 - you can buy them in pads at any art supply store.

1 small pad of arches oil paper 10 x 12

⤴ 3-8 square cradled panels no larger than 20 x 20 gesso board, clipboard

(Jerry's Sick Blick Artists and Craftsman) **gessoed for oil paint**

⤴ **choose 5-6 colors** (translucent and opaque) R&F pigment sticks + a blender stick + white and black

one large tube of titanium white oil paint and several small tubes of oil paint colors

⤴ 16 oz GAmblin cold wax medium...Jerry's, Dick Blicks

one roll of paper towel..bounty or viva

⤴ palette knife

⤴ 1 soft rubber brayer

⤴ paper palette 12" x 16" or larger

⤴ From Home depot or Painting supply place: 1 squeegee, at least one small painting roller,( blue painters tape, 1 scraper, razor blades

⤴ Drawing materials- one large graphite stick, 1 each black and white soft

apron

- ⤴ CD or photos of your own work
- ⤴ think about what inspires you? symbol, image, words, nature, etc.
- ⤴ Wax paper and something to transport wet work home.

### **Optional**

- ⤴ Assortment of oil paints
- ⤴ Markmaking tools(looking for texture): dental tools, dish scrubber, small whisk boom, scrapers, forks
- ⤴ Think stencils: things like the plastic from clementine boxes etc
